FAQs for Dog Breeders in Unincorporated Greenville County

Based on County Ordinances §§ 4-11, 4-14, 4-16, and 4-17

1. AM I REQUIRED TO REGISTER AS A PET BREEDER?

Yes. If you breed and sell dogs for profit in unincorporated Greenville County, you must register your business under the county's Business Registration Program (§ 4-16).

2. WHERE DO I REGISTER MY BREEDER BUSINESS?

Registration can be completed online HERE If you need help, contact Animal Control at animalcontrol@greenvillecounty.org or call 864-467-7595.

3.IS THERE A COST TO REGISTER?

No. Registration is free, but it is required by law.

4.HOW OFTEN MUST I RENEW MY BREEDER REGISTRATION?

Annually. You must also keep your business and contact information accurate and up to date (§ 4-16(c)).

5. WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR KENNEL OR CRATE SIZE?

Kennels must provide:

Dogs under 25 lbs: 24 sq ft Dogs 25-50 lbs: 64 sq ft Dogs over 50 lbs: 100 sq ft

Minimum width: 4 ft (≤50 lbs), 6 ft (>50 lbs)

Height: At least 12 inches taller than the standing dog

Crates are for temporary confinement only—not to exceed 12 hours in a 24-hour period

-and must allow full movement.

6. WHAT ARE THE SANITATION AND VENTILATION REQUIREMENTS?

Housing and all contact surfaces must be **cleaned and sanitized daily.** Spaces must be **well-lit during the day** and **adequately ventilated** to promote health and minimize odors (§ 4-17(a)(1)).

7. WHAT VETERINARY CARE IS REQUIRED FOR BREEDING DOGS?

You must maintain a written vet care plan approved by a licensed veterinarian, and provide:

- Annual hands-on vet exams
- Core vaccinations per AVMA guidelines
- Parasite prevention
- Prompt treatment of illness/injury
- Surgeries/euthanasia performed only by vets
- Detailed vet records for inspection (§ 4-17(a)(4))



8. DO I NEED TO PROVIDE MY DOGS WITH SOCIALIZATION OR EXERCISE?

Yes. Dogs must have access to an exercise area at least twice the size of their primary enclosure and a vet-approved socialization/enrichment plan (§ 4-17(a)(3)).

9. HOW OFTEN MUST FOOD AND WATER BE PROVIDED?

At least **twice every 24 hours** (unless directed by a vet), with fresh, uncontaminated food suited to the dog's needs. Clean water must be available at all times, and all containers cleaned daily (§ 4-11 & § 4-17(a)(2)).

10. ARE RABIES VACCINATIONS AND TAGS REQUIRED?

Yes. Dogs must be vaccinated for rabies and wear the issued rabies tag at all times outdoors (§ 4-14(a-b)).

11. IS ADDITIONAL IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED FOR MY DOGS?

Yes. All dogs over 3 months must wear:

- A tag with current owner contact info, or
- A registered microchip with up-to-date info

Rabies tags alone do not meet this requirement (§ 4-14(d)).

12. WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T FOLLOW THESE RULES?

Each violation is a **separate offense** and can result in fines or other penalties, determined by magistrate court guidelines (§ 4-17(b)).
