

Dear Miss Ollie:

I am enclosing herewith for recording deed of Charles H. Whitman (or Whitworth) to Alma Bennefield. Also enclosed is my check for \$1.03 which does not include anything for stamps. In the transfer from Alma Bennefield to him sometime ago, the consideration was that he was to take care of her for her life and also to assume and pay off a mortgage on the premises given by Alma. But that arrangement was soon broken up and he reconveys the property to Alma and she is assuming the same mortgage that he had assumed previously. In fact, no money in either of the transactions was passed. But please advise if stamps are due herein.

This party has not two names; his real name is Charles Whitman, but someone in Greenville who drew the deed from Alma Bennefield to him made the mistake of putting his name as "Whitworth" in one or two places on the deed and in other places the name "Whitman" was shown; so I used both names on this deed.
