KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.A. Allison of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Greenville County (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Greenville County, its successors and assigns; All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, about two miles from the Court House, on both sides of the Rutherford Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake XOM; on this (City) side of the bridge across Richland Creek; thence S. 43 E. 5.18 to a stake XOM; thence S. 31 E. 2.55 to stake XOM; thence N. 45 E. 7.60 to stake XOM; thence N. 32 W. 87 links to stake XOM; thence N. 13-1/2 E. 2.50 to stake XOM; thence N. 39 W. 5. to dead sassafras (gone); thence N. 45 W. 5.50 to stake XOM; thence S. 45-1/4 W. 11.08 to stake XNM on road; thence N. 52 W. 10 to stake XNM; thence S. 38 W. 9 to stake XNM; thence S. 62-1/2 E. 14.50 to beginning corner, containing twenty-five acres, more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Mary Winn by deed dated February 19th., 1902 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Volume I.I.I. page 567.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville County, its successors heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Greenville County, its successors

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
