KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W.H. Bozeman of the County of Greenville

and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and forty-six Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

T.B. Wood of the County of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

T.B. Wood of Simpsonville, S.C. all my undivided one-half interest of all that lot, piece or parcel of land lying, being and situate in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid: Commencing at a stake on edge of Georgia Road; thence N. 42-1/4 W. 4.05 to stake on edge of Baloms; thence S. 37 W. 8.78 to stone; thence S. 31-1/4 E. 8.22 to a stone; thence N. 70-1/2 E. 4.90 to red-0; thence S. 61 E. 17.34 to a stake; thence S. 42-1/4 E. 12.40 to Georgia Road thence with said road 21 links to the beginning corner, containing fourteen and 6/10 acres more or less, bounded by lands of Lillie Black, John Holland, B.M. Moore and T.B. Wood

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

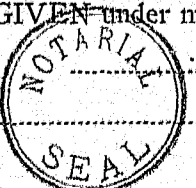
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER.
