in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and twenty-five dollars and Love and Affections,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents byWillis N. Taylor of Greenville, Co., (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Willis N. Taylor, all of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being
about six miles East of the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville and State of South-
Carolina: It being the same tract of land deeded to Susan E. Taylor by Geo. Westmoreland on the
10th, day of May 1884, recorded in book B. page 50, containing sixty acres, more or less and
bounded by lands of Henry Watson on the South; Thomas Jones on the East; Thomas Cole on the West
Pack King on the North.TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

Willis N. Taylor, his heirs and assigns, forever.
