(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

N.A. Quinn, his heirs and assigns all that certain lot or parcel of land situated and being just outside of the City limits of Greenville, S.C. and known as Lot No. 35; ( number thirty-five) in plat of -- survey of land of W.M. Norwood, known as Norwood Heights, made by J.N. Southern surveyor bearing date of October 9th, 1906 and recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book A. on page 133, said lot has a frontage of fifty feet (50 ft.) on Vance Street and is one hundred and fifty feet (150 ft.) deep.
