

Susan Lacy Deed TO J.C. Thompson

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Susan Lacy of the City of Knoxville and State of Tennessee in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.C. Thompson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release into the said

J.C. Thompson, his heirs and assigns, all that lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, containing seventy-six one-hundredths of one acre and bounded as follows:

Beginning on a red oak William Chanless corner, and running; thence N. 18 E. 3.30 chains to a sassafrass; thence S. 85 W. 3.18 chains to stone corner; thence S. 4-1/2 W. 1.75 chains to stake in fence; thence S. 90 E. 3 chains to the beginning, adjoining lot of William Chandler on the East line and lands of Emmala Beard, Elizabeth E. Jones on the other three sides being the lot of land conveyed to me by Josephine B. Norwood by deed dated the 8th, day of December 1899 and recorded in Vol. F.F.F. page 806.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.C. Thompson, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J.C. Thompson, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
