KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.C. Rasor

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Four thousand and fifty (\$4050.00) Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.W. Norwood and L.O. Patterson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.W. Norwood and L.O. Patterson, share and share alike, and to their heirs and assigns forever, All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in the fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, including Lots numbered six (6) and seven (7) of the Jail Lot according to a plat thereof prepared by J.N. Southern, bearing date May 21, 1891 and filed in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, South Carolina in Book "W.W" of Deeds and having according to such plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Broad Street, on the Northeast corner of lot belonging to Alvin H. Dean, (formerly belonging to George Heldmann) and running; thence along Dean's line and the old line of the Heldmann lot S. 20° W. one hundred and ten (110) feet to a stake on an Alley; thence along line of said Alley S. 70° E. fifty (50) feet to a stake on line of Lot No. 5, belonging to H. Endel; thence along Endel's line N. 20° E. one hundred and ten (110) feet to a stake on the South side of Broad Street; thence along said Broad Street N. 70° W. fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner, all of which will fully appear by reference to said plat, filed in said Book "W.W" of deeds at page, 561; this being the same land conveyed to me, the said W.C. Rasor by Mrs. Sarah E. Sirrine by her deed bearing date February 26th, 1910 and recorded in the office above mentioned on March 4th, 1910 in Book No three (3) of deeds at page 284, it being understood that about nine (9) feet of the rear portion of this lot is included in the alley-way above mentioned, and is sold subject to such rights as the public may have acquired therein.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.W. Norwood and L.O. Patterson, share and share alike, and their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J.W. Norwood and L.O. Patterson, and their

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
