Compton of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

L.N. Compton, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, just outside the City limits of the City of Greenville and known as Lot 106, on plat recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 133, and being bounded on the North and Northeast by Main Street and Lot No. 105 on East by lot No. 105, now owned by Charles F. Lancaster; on the South by Southern Railroad right of way, and on the West by Lots Nos. 42, 43, 44, and 45 owned by W.M. Norwood and by lot No. 46, owned by John Distler. This being a part of the property deeded to me by Mary A. Williams, and to her by Barr and McCuen.
