

Mary and W.P. Taylor Deed TO Walter C. Taylor

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Mary Taylor and W.P. Taylor of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Walter C. Taylor

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Walter C. Taylor All that lot of land designated as Lot No. 6, surveyed by Will D. Neves Mar. 19, 1910 in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being a part of the land deeded to Mary Taylor by her Mother Mrs. Nancy Hawkins, April 8, 1880 and recorded in Book A. page 171 Auditors office and in Vol. K.K. page 415 Register Mesne Conveyance, bounded by lands of Mary Taylor on the South and Lots No. 5-1 and 7: Beginning on an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 5, on my line and running N. 25 E. 7.94 chs. to a stone corner of Lots No. 1 and 3; thence S. 75 E. 2.16 chs. to center of new road; thence along said road 4.88 chs. to stone in center of the road; thence N. 75 W. 1.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 25 W. to iron pin on corner of lot No. 7; thence N. 51-35 W. to beginning, and containing 2.66 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Walter C. Taylor, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Walter C. Taylor, his

heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
