in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

C.H. Weisner (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C.H. Weisner all that lot or parcel of land, being, lying and situate in the County and State aforesaid, and known as Lot No. 39 of Block B. in the survey made by J.A. Adams and bounded by lands of J.P. Kellett formerly owned by C.L. Waddell, W.T. Vaughan, Telfair Street and other lots of H.L. Shaw; said lot (No.39) having 50 feet front on Telfair Street, running back 245 feet feet to corner of Waddell, J.P. Kellett and Vaughans land, 94 feet on W.T. Vaughans land, and 262 feet on Lot No. 38 as in said Plat made by J.A. Adams.
