KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H.H. Harris, of the City of Greenville
County of Greenville in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Thirty-five and no/100 Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.P. Vaughan and the further consideration of

two notes of \$30.00 each, due June 23, 1910 and June 23, 1911 respectively (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
W.P. Vaughan, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and
being in Greenville City, County and State aforesaid, in Ward Six on a Street recently opened and
owned by H.H. Harris, being known as Lot No. 22, of the plat made by W.A. Hudson March 21st, 1908
of the lands purchased by me from B.E. Geer and from S.A. Moore, said plat being on Record in the
office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County. Said lot has the following
metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron stake corner on the above mentioned Street and running in an Easternly
direction with said Street 50 feet to an iron stake, corner; thence in a Northernly direction
toward Grove Street 70 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Westernly direction along the line of
Lot No. 9 of said plat 50 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Southernly direction 70 feet to the
beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
W.P. Vaughan, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W.P. Vaughan, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my those heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same, or any part thereof.
