KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.E. Burden, of Greenville County, and

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty and no/100 Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

M.S. Staton (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M.S. Staton, his heirs and assigns, All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being about two miles West of Greenville Court House, South Carolina, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, near the Monaghan Mills and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

LOT No. 9: Beginning at a stake on Cobb Street, corner of Lot No. 10 and running; thence with line of Lot No. 10, S. 12-44 W. 158.3 feet to a stake on line of Lot No. 14; thence with line of Lots Nos. 14 & 13 S. 81-36 E. 52.5 feet to an iron pin, corner Lot No. 8; thence with line of Lot No. 8, N. 12-44 E. 156.8 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 8 on Cobb Street; thence with line of Cobb Street N. 80 W. 52.5 feet to the beginning corner.

LOT No. 10: Beginning at an iron pin on Cobb Street, corner of Lot No. 11 and running; thence with line of Lot No. 11, S. 12-44 W. 159.8 feet to an iron pin, on line of Lot No. 15; thence with line of Lots Nos. 15 and 14, S. 81-36 E. 52.5 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 9; thence with line of Lot No. 9, N. 12-44 E. 158.3 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 9 on Cobb Street; thence with line of Cobb Street N. 80 W. 52.5 feet to the beginning corner, and are adjoining each other, being known as Lots No. 9 and No. 10 according to a plat made By R.E. Dalton, on June 7th, 1910 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A. at page 409.

And being a part of a tract of land conveyed to me, the said J.E. Burden by Emma S. Miller Deed recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County, in South Carolina, in Deed Book ZZZ at page 568.

I formerly conveyed these two lots of land Nos. 9 and 10 to M.S. Staton by a deed dated December 24th, 1909 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in South Carolina, in Deed Book Volume 5, at page 304; but there was an error in the survey and in the plats, (recorded in Plat Book A. at pages 305 and 401) and a new survey was made and is now recorded in Plat Book A. at page 409 in above mentioned office, and this Deed is made to correct said error.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said M.S. Staton, his

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said M.S. Staton, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
