KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J.P. Poole, P.B. Lipscomb and P.H. Harbin, deacons of the Laurel Creek Baptist Church in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Dollars,
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Lavinia Rowley (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lavinia Rowley, all that piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and about three miles East of the City of Greenville and containing one acre more or less, and has the following marks, bearings and distances, to wit:
 Beginning at a stake 3XOM on J.P. Poole's line; thence N. 13 E. 2.55 to a stake 3XOM in field; thence N. 53-3/4 W. 4.00 to a stake 3XOM; thence S. 13 W. 2.55 to a stake 3XOM; thence S. 53-3/4 E. 4.00 to the beginning corner and bounded by lands of J.P. Poole, Lavinia Rowley and others & being the same land conveyed to the deacons of the Laurel Creek Baptist Church by deed from John H. Vaughan.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Lavinia Rowley, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves, our successors, heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lavinia Rowley, her

heirs and assigns, against us and our successors, heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
