KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John T. Bramlett of Greenville County
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

A.W. Holliday (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said A.W. Holliday all that certain lot or lots of land on Morgan Hill on New Cut or Bramlett Road, known as Lots No. 62 and 63 as shown by plat made by J.E. Sirrine and recorded in R.M.C. office of Greenville County, said lots being and lying on New Cut or Bramlett Road, containing 60 feet front each and having a depth of 200 feet each, containing in the said two lots 24000 sq. feet, adjoining lots No. 64 and 61 of said survey as shown by said Plat.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said A.W. Holliday, his heirs and assigns, forever.
AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A.W. Holliday, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
