KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, I. E. Wood, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five and 60/100 Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by The Office of Clear Spring Camp No. 553, Wood-

men of the World. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Officers of Clear Spring Camp of Woodman No. 553 and their successors all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Austin Township on the Scuffletown Road at the intersection with the Clear Spring Church road, adjoining lands of F. D. Hunter, I. E. Wood and others; having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone in Scuffletown Road; thence N. 55-1/2 W. 3.62 chains to stone; thence N. 48-1/2 E. 3.64 to stone; thence S. 3-1/4 E. 4.50 to the beginning, containing sixty-four one-hundredths of an acre, more or less.
