KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That F.L. Stone

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Stone Land Company, a corporation under the

Laws of South Carolina (and quit claim) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Stone Land Company all my right, title and interest in and to that certain tract of Twenty acres, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, which shall be laid off for my use as aforesaid from the Northeast corner of said Land, as recited in my deed to Stone Land Company of March 16th, 1903, recorded in R.M.C. Office in book J.J.J. page 440.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Stone Land Company, its successors heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

heirs and assigns, against and heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
