in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty-one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W.M. Jackson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W.M. Jackson, all that certain lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid on the West side of Pinckney St. and being Lot No. 18 on plat of land of W.P. McBee deceased, prepared by J.N. Southern, D.S. on May 16th, 1902. For more complete description see said plat recorded in Plat Book A. page 83, R.M.C. office Greenville County. See also deed of F.B. McBee to Amy S. Ewbank, Vol. S.S.S. P, 333, and deed of Amy S. Ewbank to Wm. D. Parrish, Vol. 5, P., 529.
