KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John T. Howard, of Marion County, Texas

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty-nine Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Andrew S. Howard of Simpsonville County of Greenville, and State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Andrew S. Howard, all of my right, title and interest of or into any or singular that piece parcel or lot of land lying and being situated in Greenville County, State aforesaid bounded by lands of David Burdett, Jim Gault, Tobe Hunter and A.S. Howard, it being the Home Place of my Father, the late John M. Howard and containing one hundred and sixty-eight acres, more or less.

Also my interest in one hundred and fifty dollars worth of personal property and the seventy-five dollars willed me by my Father.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew S. Howard, and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Andrew S. Howard, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

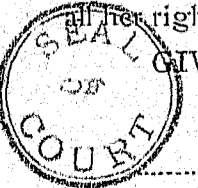
