KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Cora L. Coleman in the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid

and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G.L. Coleman in the State aforesaid, Greenville Co.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

G.L. Coleman, all my interest (being 1/3) of a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and known as the land of the Estate of Jinnie Bishop, and shall include all my interest at present or whatever interest I shall have hereafter. Said land is bounded by lands of Frank Hunt, Sanders McCauley, Lee McCauley and others and containing fifty-seven acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

G.L. Coleman, his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said G.L. Coleman, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my any other heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
