KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Ammie Jamison

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five thousand Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Walter W. Green

(the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Walter W. Green, his heirs and assigns all that tract of land on the West side of the Laurens road, about 3-1/2 miles from Greenville Court-house, Greenville County, South Carolina:

Beginning at a stone on the East side of said Road and running; thence N. 88 W. 5.13 to a stone 3X; thence N. 73-1/2 W. 3.41 to a stone 3X; thence S. 4 E. 4.36 to stone 3X in a road; thence along said road S. 68 W. 3.50 to a stone 3X; thence S. 1-1/2 E. 13.98 to a stone 3X P.O. gone; thence S. 84 E. 6.20 to a stone 3X; thence N. 1-1/2 E. 17.44 to a stone 3X in a road. (stone on the North side); thence N. 70 E. 4.86 to the beginning, containing eleven and 86/100 acres, more or less, and being the land conveyed to me by Mary E. Goodlett, Jany. 25, 1889 and recorded in Book V.V. page 103.

Also all that other lot of land in same locality, and on West side of the Laurens Road: Beginning at a stone 3X on said road and running with said road N. 31 W. 5.50 to a bend; thence N. 51-3/4 W. 3.64 to corner in the road opposite a stone; thence S. 29 W. 6.30 to a stone 3X; thence S. 73-1/2 E. 3.41 to a stone 3X; thence S. 88 E. 5.13 to the beginning, containing three acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to me by J.P. Poole, 30 December 1889 and recorded in Book V.V. page 459.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Walter W. Green, his

heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Walter W. Green, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
