(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said O.M. Moore, all that certain parcel or tract of land situated & being in the County of Greenville & State aforesaid in Glassy Mountain Township on both sides of South Pacolet River having the following metes & bounds according to survey made by J.B. Livingston dated February 14, 1906 to wit Beginning at a dead chestnut & running thence N. 12 E. 50 poles to a stake in field; thence due west 90 poles to a stake near rock; thence S. 13 W. 35 poles to an oak near the road, thence S. 50 E. 22 poles to an oak across the Creek, thence due east 53 poles to the beginning corner containing twenty eight (28) acres more or less (conveyed to me by R.E. Johnston.

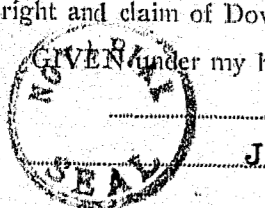
