 Olive A. Peace, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
 State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville,
 fronting on Dunbar Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning at an
