acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Minnie Middleton all that piece parcel or lot of land being known as Lot No. nine "Block D" of the Sterling Annex, said Sterling Annex being located just beyond the limits of the City of Greenville south of Jay Road Street and adjoining the property formerly known as Sterling College. acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said George G. Byers all that certain lot of land situate in Ward one of the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid on the South side of West Gate Street line between Robinson and Wilcox Streets, being the eastern half of Lot No. 8 of Section 4, according to plat of Property of Stone Lumber Company, made by J. E.
