acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Benjamin Jesse Coleman, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated among and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Bata Township on the head waters of Enoree River about 1/2 mile south of the intersection of the White Horse and Ben Come Roads and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of the White Horse Road and running thence N 60 1/2 W 9.15 chains to a stone, thence S 81 W 4.16 chains to a stone, thence S 23 1/2 W 2.37 chains to a stone, thence S 33 3/4 W 6.50 chains to a stake on left bank of Branch, thence N 79 W 6.28 chains to a W.O. thence S 61 W 6.86 chains to a stake on road, thence along said road in a southerly direction 12.55 chains to a stake on said road, thence S 34 E 15.9 chains to a stake, thence S 70 E 15.33 chains to a pine on the north side of the White Horse Road, thence S 75 1/2 E 7.00 chains to a stake in ditch, thence down said ditch N 67 E 8.55 chains to a stake in said ditch, thence up Spring Branch 3.07 chains to a stake in said Spring Branch, thence S 87 E 10.43 chains to a stone, thence N 14 E 5.00 chains to a stake, thence N 47 W 28.50 chains to the beginning point and containing twenty and 5/100 acres, more or less (and being a part or all of the same tract of land conveyed to me by the said Leila J. Anderson, All that certain lot of land situated on the south side of N. Colby Street in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, County of South Carolina, in the block between Richardson and Academy Streets and being more fully described as follows: Beginning on the south side of N.
