C. F. McCullough and Mary Foster McCullough, all that piece  
parcel or tract of land situate in Han Kins Township,  
County and State aforesaid, containing 310.4 acres, more  
or less, being more fully described in plat of recent  
date by P. E. Dalton, Civil Engineer and being part of the entire  
tract of land recently conveyed by me to T. J. Martin and  
by T. J. Martin conveyed to me by his deed dated May  
1st, 1915, recorded in R. M. C. Office for County and State  
aforesaid, in Vol. 20 page 544.
