Bray, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and bounded on the Runcombe Road and the Branch Road, and being a part of tract No. 2 of the Division of the Estate of J. I. McKinney, def. crossed land conveyed to John T. and Leila J. McKinney by A. T. Sullivan, Trustee by his deed dated August 26th 1903 and recorded in the T. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 220, page 775, and having the following metes and bounds, as described August 30th 1918 by W. A. S. Dean, thence with Perry Avenue north two hundred (200) feet to the lot now formerly owned by W. S.
