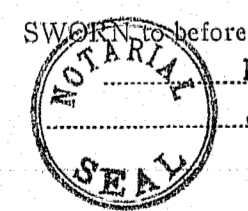


Harriet J. Talley DEED TO William A. Talley

 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Harriet J. Talley of Greenville County, S.C.
 in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty (450.) DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 William A. Talley (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 William A. Talley, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in
 State of S.C., Greenville County on both sides of a Road leading from the Pickens Road
 at A.B. Talleys to the Marietta Road at Talleys Bridge and on waters of N. Saluda River,
 bounded by lands of A.B. Talley Estate, T.W. Talleys Estate, R.D. Talleys and others,
 containing Twenty-eight and three fourths (28-3/4) acres, be the same more or less and
 as follows, Viz:
 Beginning at a stone formerly W.O. on the branch line of R.D. Talley's land and runs;
 thence S. 76 W. 11.00 ch. to a stone 3XOM; thence S. 13-3/4 E. 29.10 ch. to a Hickory 3X
