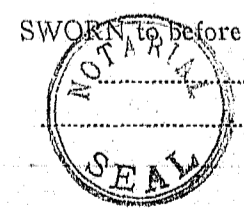

 to me by W.C. Cleveland by deed dated Jan. 30, 1911.

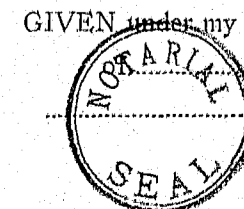

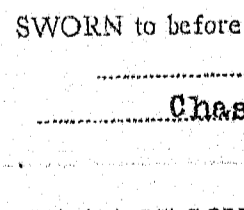
