is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 Frances M. McDavid, all my one half undivided interest in the following
 lot or parcel of land, conveyed to me on March 4th 1914 by P.A.
 McDavid, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State
 Vol. 28, page 276 and described as follows: All that certain piece, parcel
 and lot of land situate, lying and being in the county of Green-
 ville, State aforesaid, and in the City of Greenville, having the fol-
 lowing metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an corner point
 corner of fifteen-foot alley, 215' N. from Pettigree Street, thence 5.65' E 165' 3" along said alley to iron pin corner of Lot No. 6, thence 4.15' E 64' 4" to another pin corner of Lot No. 6 and 5' 5", thence N 76° 45' E, 150' 3" to iron pin on Gay Street, thence 5.15' E along Gay Street 54' to the beginning corner, known as Block 7 Lot 10 revised sub-division of Boyce Lawn property, Plat being recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A"
 at page 179, and being the same lot conveyed unto P.A. McDavid
 and Frances M. McDavid by Malissa P. Childress on January
