Required to be given or filed by Administrators, Executors, Guardians, Curators, Committees of Incompetents, Receivers, Receivers and Trustees in Bankruptcy: Provided that no such bonds shall be issued hereunder where the penalty shall exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30.000).

- (2). Required to filed with the Internal Revenue Bureau or with a Collector of Customs, with penalties not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5.000).
- (3). Required to be filed by any public officials (except treasurers, sheriffs, constables, and officers collecting taxes) conditioned for the faithful performance of duties or as by statute required: with penalties not exceeding Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15.000).
- (4). Required to be given or filed by any State, City, Town and County as a prerequisite to conducting business, keeping explosives and all "permit" and "license" bonds (except liquor and excess bonds) with penalties not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5.000),

Such Bonds and Undertakings for said purposes when duly executed by one of the aforesaid Agents and countersigned or attested by one of the aforesaid Attorneys in fact, shall be binding upon the said Company as fully and to all intents and purpose as if such Bonds and Undertakings had been duly executed and acknowledged and delivered by the regularly elected officers of the Company, IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the MARYLAND CASUALTY COMPANY, has caused these presents to be signed by its Vice President and its Secretary, and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed this Seventh day of February 1911.at the City of Baltimore, Maryland,
