WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration Dollars the said Foreign Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention does grant unto the said Ransome J. Williams with General Warranty, all that lot and parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in Ward No. 6, at the corner of McKay and Hammett Streets, running sixty-six feet on McKay Street and forty-two feet on Hammett Street, and having a four room dwelling and stable thereon.

This deed is executed by authority of a resolution of the Foreign Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention adopted this 9th, day of February 1911, a copy of which is hereto attached. The said party of the first part covenants that it has the right to convey the said land to the grantee: that it has done no act to encumber the said land; that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances, and that the said party of the first part, will execute such further assurance of the said land as may be requisite.
