Subject, however, to the following easements and road ways, to wit:

- 1. A right of way heretofore granted unto Southern Railway Company in October 1902, for the purpose of constructing a spur track from the main line of said Railway Company to Monaghan Mills.
- 2. Rights of way heretofore granted to Southern Railway Company for its industrial tracks extending to former works of Virginia-Carolina Chemical Company, as shown by deed therefor, recorded in R.M.C. office for said County in Book "HHH", page 287.
- 3. Pinckney Street and its extension across the tract described herein to Buncombe Road.
- 4. A road-way extending across the second tract herein described from the Finley Bridge Road to Buncombe Road. Also a road or Street known as Buncombe Road and the old road extending along Northwestern line of the last described tract, connecting Buncombe Road with Finlay Bridge Road.
- 5. The easement heretofore granted unto Southern Power Company for its transmission lines. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances in said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises above granted unto the said F.W. Poe-Manufacturing Company, its successors and assigns forever.
