Whereas, Sarah N. Key, George A. Norwood, Lula N. Mullin, Clara N. Watson, Samuel W. Norwood, Joseph Norwood and Annie N. Moss, did by deed bearing date the 11th, day of December, 1909 convey to me, J.W. Alverson, All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and City of Greenville, fronting on Pinckney Street and known as Lot No. 18, on plat of W.A. Hudson, bearing date July Sth, 1908 and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Pinckney Street at corner of lot of said J.N. Alverson and running; thence S. 34 E. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34 W. 36 feet to an iron pin on said J.N. Alverson's line; thence S. 56 W. 150 feet along said J.N. Alverson's line to the beginning corner.

An undivided seven-eighths interest in said lot of land is hereby conveyed by me as such trustee under said deed of trust, and an undivided one-eighth interest therein is hereby conveyed by me in my individual right.

And I do hereby bind said persons who have executed and delivered to me said deed of trust as aforesaid, their heirs, executors and administrators in so far as I have a right to bind them under the provisions of said deed of trust, to warrant and forever defend all and singular their undivided seven-eighths interest in said premises and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular my undivided one-eighth interest in the said premises unto the said J.N. Alverson, his heirs and assigns against said persons who have executed and delivered to me said deed of trust as aforesaid and their heirs and against myself and my heirs and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
