Know all men by these presents that Greenville Trust Company, a corporation of the State of South Carolina, and C.C. Good, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and the benefits to be derived, have granted, sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant, sell and convey unto Paris Mountain Water Company, the right to lay a water main of such size as it may choose, underneath the surface of Park Street and extending to Briggs Avenue. Said Streets are run through a portion of the Old Verner property west of the City of Greenville. Said water main shall at all times belong to said Paris Mountain Water Company and said Company shall at all times have the right to enter upon the property through which said streets run to repair said water main, make connections and do all other things incident to maintaining a water supply. Said Paris Mountain Water Company may enter upon said property and remove said water main at such time as it may see fit so to do, and to that end full permission is hereby granted to do it.

It is expressly understood that the Paris Mountain Water Company shall have the right to make contracts with consumers along the line of said main and may charge consumers the customary water rates and tapping fees which prevail within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the rights and privileges herein granted to the Paris Mountain Water Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, successors and assigns to warrant and defend all and singular the premises herein to the grantee, its successors and assigns forever.

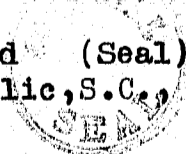
