Know all men by these presents that I, Stephen D. Keith of the County of Pickens, State of South Carolina, have this 26, day of January 1865 sold and released unto Bengamine Masters (Sr), his heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Greenville Counties on Blue Ridge Mountains crossing by Laurel Creek bounded as follows, on South by Saluda River on West by Saluda River on North by North Carolina line, thence east to Slicker Creek, down said Creek to Spruce Pine, thence Southwest course to Chestnut oak, thence to a beach on bank of River said boundary of land containing (1000) one thousand acres, more or less, being the same land conveyed to me by John H. Masters dated December 12th, 1861 consideration being \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) this January 26th, 1865.
