Greenville, the necessary rights of way for the change in the location of the public road through said premises made necessary by the proposed overhead bridge over the tracks of the Railway Company, as shown on blue print hereto attached, marked "B", and said Suber agrees to execute such instruments, in writing, as may be reasonably required by the Railway Company, or the County of Greenville, covering said proposed change. Said Suber reserves title to all of the timber growing on said proposed right of way for change of road.

- 4. The Railway Company agrees that it will obtain from C.L. King and convey, or cause to be conveyed to W.H. Suber the right or privilege to raise the present mill dam of said Suber three feet, and said W.H. Suber agrees that he will release the Railway Company from any and all demands, claims or liability under its contract to protect the water rights of the said W.H. Suber; that said W.H. Suber, his heirs and assigns, shall and may at all times rest the water in his dam against the fill or roadway of said Company.
- 5. The Railway Company agrees that it will locate at some convenient point on the property of said Suber within a reasonable time, a local flag stop.
