(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
 D.L. Hill, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate  
 lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid on Grove Street,  
 designated as lots Nos. "7" and "20" on a plat of the land purchased by me from B.E. Geer and  
 S.A. Moore, made by W.A. Hudson, March 21st, 1908, and registered in the office of the  
 Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" page 225, said lots  
 together being described as follows:
