(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 Greenville Trust Co., all the following described piece or parcel of land situate, lying and
 being in the State and County aforesaid and in Butler Township, being a part of the Jerry M.-
 Kilgore Home Place, and bounded as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin standing in the South line of the aforesaid place and runs; thence
 N. 38-1/2 E. 565 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55 W. 320 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71
 W. 575 feet to an iron pin in the said South line above mentioned and thence with same S. 45
