the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louisa Brockman Robertson, All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the

County and State aforesaid, in the South-western part of the City of Greenville, near the incorporate limits, known as Lot No. 7 in plat of survey of the land of Aaron Brockman, deceased, made by J.N. Southern, Surveyor on the 4th, day of September, 1911 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume "A", page 539, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron stake corner of lot No. 5 on 20' Street and running; thence S. 12-1/2 W. 48' to an iron stake; thence S. 77-1/2 E. 95' to an iron stake; thence N. 12-1/2 E. 48' to an iron stake; thence N. 77-1/2 W. 95' to an iron stake at the beginning corner. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said

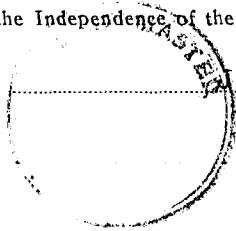
Louisa Brockman Robertson, her
