the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said E.H. Holliday, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, in Dunklin Township, and known as tract No. 2 on plat of the lands of John B. Williams, deceased, made by J.M.
