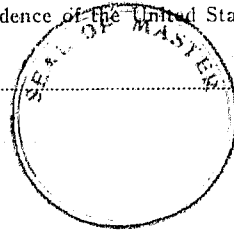
Frances Hall Hunter all that certain lot or parcel of land just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid known as lot No. 7 in the plat of survey of lands of James Hall, deceased, recorded in R.M.C. office in book C. page 90, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the south side of public road leading from Laurens road to Nickletown road, corner of lot No. 9; thence S. 63° 48' W. 138.5 to a stake corner of lot No. 5; thence with line of lot No. 5, S. 1° 53' E. 324.3 feet to a stake, corner of lots 5, 6, 8; thence N. 70° 45' E. 122.5 feet to a stake corner of lots 8, 9, 10; thence N. 0° 03' E. 344.7 feet to the beginning corner.
