I, E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING: WHEREAS, Edwin Pepper

on or about the 9th day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fourteen exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Elizabeth M. Pepper, et al.,

relief as to

demanding the real estate described in the complaint to be partitioned among the parties interested therein; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th day of January 1915, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. A. Cason, Souie Cason, Mary Wilson for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 5016).

NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said W. A. Cason,

Souie Cason, Mary Wilson, Wade Cason and Arthur Cason, the following described real estate: All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in Grove Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 117 acres and being Tract No. 4 of the W. A. Pepper estate according to a plat made by W. F. See, surveyor, in December, 1914 and having the following meters and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in Old Grove road to Piedmont, joint corner of Tract No. 3 and Tract No. 4, and running S. 16 1/2 W. 10.50 to a stone x 30 m; thence S. 41 3/4 E. 5.55 to a stone x 30 m; thence S. 3 1/2 W. 12.50 to a stone x 3 m; thence S. 80 E. 13.14 to a stone x 3 m in fork of branch; thence N. 83 3/4 E. 26.90 to large Persimmon tree x 30 m; thence N. 78 10 E. 47.56 to a stone x 30 m; thence N. 47 W. 6.77 to stone; thence N. 12 E. 7.96 to a stone; thence N. 79 3/4 W. 54.28 to iron pin at the beginning corner.

The respective interests herein conveyed are intended to be in the following proportion: To W. A. Cason a one-third undivided interest and to Souie Cason, Mary Wilson, Wade Cason and Arthur Cason, each, a one-sixth undivided interest.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said W. A. Cason, Souie Cason, Mary Wilson, Wade Cason and Arthur Cason, their heirs and assigns forever.
