P. Chappell to Harriett Hogan, recorded in R.M.C. office, in Volume "F. F. F." page 482, and being the same lot on which is situate a house now occupied by the said Robert W. Neal.

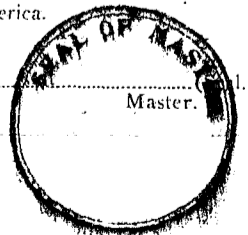
