 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Palmer Pruitt, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, unto the said
 Palmer Pruitt, all of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being in Greenville
 County and State aforesaid near Bennetts Bridge on Enoree River, being Tract No. 3, of the
 J.H. Snow lands as shown on a plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, December 5th, 1906:
 Beginning at a stake formerly sour-wood, Thompsons line Creek and running S. 65-3/4 E. 3.78
 to a post-oak; thence N. 28-3/4 E. 29.06 to a pine-knot; thence N. 68-2/3 W. 36.90 to a stake;
