We, Tandy Bishop, L.B. Bishop, W.S. Bishop, Charlie Bishop, G.W. Bishop, Stella Foster, Lina McCauley, Cassie Darnell

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That and Ida Ballew, nine of the heirs at law and distributees of Mrs. Mary-Ann Bishop, deceased, who died intestate, leaving as her sole heirs at law and distributees her ten children Viz:- Tandy Bishop, L.B. Bishop, W.S. Bishop, Charlie Bishop, R. Bishop, G.W. Bishop, Stella Foster, Lina McCauley, Cassie Darnell and Ida Ballew, all of the County of Greenville, except Charlie Bishop, who lives in the State aforesaid in Spartanburg County, and

Six hundred and seventy-five and no/100 (\$675.00) DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. Bishop, of the County of Greenville

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

R. Bishop, his heirs and assigns, All our right, title and undivided interest in and to all those two certain tracts of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Bates Township on waters of Enoree River, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: First tract: Beginning at a Hickory corner, and running; thence N. 27-1/2 W. 8.00 to a pine-stump; thence S. 88 W. 8.00 to a stake; thence S. 27-1/2 E. 8.00 to a stake; thence N. 88 E. 8.00 to the beginning corner and containing six and one-fourth (6-1/4) acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Mary-Ann Bishop by Emily C. McGowan, et al by a deed bearing date 7th, day of March, 1906 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book "S.S.S" at page 117.

Second tract: Beginning on Rock 3XOM; thence N. 6 W. 3.40 to rock; thence N. 64-1/2 E. 25.20 to a rock; thence S. 88-1/2 E. 11.55 to a rock; thence N. 42-1/2 E. 15.00 to a rock; thence S. 63-3/4 W. 24.40 to a rock; thence S. 68 W. 28.50 to a rock XOM; thence S. 23 E. 5.00 to the beginning corner and containing Nine and one-half (9-1/2) acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Mary-Ann Bishop by R.T.
