

P.J. Alexas DEED TO John P. Alexas

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, P.J. Alexas of the County of Greenville, and

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Twenty-four hundred and no/100

DOLLARS,

to me

in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by John P. Alexas

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

John P. Alexas, his heirs and assigns, All my right, title and interest (the same being one undivided one-half interest) in and to all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Main Street in the City and County of Greenville, S.C.

Beginning on said Street line at a point forty-one feet and seven inches from the intersection of Main and Broad Streets and runs; thence along the line of the Bridges and Haley lot, One hundred feet to an alley; thence in a parallel line with and one-hundred feet from said Main Street twenty-four feet, thence in a line parallel with the said Bridges and Haley lot One hundred feet to said Main Street; thence along said Street, twenty-four feet to the beginning being part of the lot conveyed to T.F. Hunt by Sallie R. Davisson by deed dated the 2nd, day of August, 1909 and recorded in Book four, page 539, and being the same lot conveyed to A.K. Manos and P.J. Alexas by said T.F. Hunt, by his deed dated Sept. 9, 1910 and recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Vol. Six, page 123. The Alley above referred to is stated to be twelve feet wide.
