Irvine and Vardry Cotton Mills and running thence N. 31 W. three hundred twenty-two (322) feet to an iron pin on road; thence N. 35-3/4 E. three hundred seventeen (317) feet along side road to an iron pin; thence S. 26 E. two hundred forty-nine (249) feet to the stump of a sycamore tree about the middle of the falls on Reedy Diver; thence S. 31.20 W. four hundred twenty and one-half $(420\frac{1}{2})$ feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the west by Main Street; on the North by Reedy River; on the East by Vardry Cotton Mills and Furman University, and on the South by W.H.
