KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, W. A. Gibeath

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Five Dollars and other valuable consideration

DOLLARS,

to me

in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by O. P. Mills

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

O. P. Mills, his heirs and assigns all of my undivided one half interest of, in and to all that certain tract of land situate in the county and State aforesaid containing one hundred and ninety-eight acres, more or less, and in accordance with a survey made by John Bowen of date the 11th day of December 1853, plat recorded in Location Book 10 at page 77, and hath the following courses and distances, to wit:— Beginning at a rock 37 nm and runs thence N. 80 W. 47.25 to a Hickory; thence N. 3, 19 W. 5.75 to a rock 37 nm; thence N. 15 W. 11, to stake 37 nm; thence ~~thence~~ N. 58 E. 9.00 to W. 0, 37 nm; thence N. 27 E. 13.60 to Chestnut 37 nm; thence S. 80 E. 16.69 to Spanish Oak 37 nm; thence S. 58 E. 23.10 to a Hickory 37 nm; thence S. 8 E. 23.60 to small Black Oak; thence S. 16 W. 2.50 to Rock 37 nm, the beginning corner; adjoining the North Carolina line on the North and East, the lands formerly early Corbin on the West and lands of O. P. Mills on the South, which said Mills lands were conveyed to him by the Secretary of State by deed dated the 14th day of November 1908, recorded in Grant Book Vol. 91 page 131; and in office of R. M. C. Greenville County Book PPP at page 230; the interest hereby conveyed being the same conveyed to me by James S. Ambler by deed dated the 18th day of April 1905 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Book 000 page 119; the other undivided interest being held by George W. Wilson under a deed from Nancy Galloway, and she from Sarah Trammell and she with J. H. Ambler from J. E. Hagood.
