is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

John F. Horroch, One undivided interest in "that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid known as the Algodinia Cotton Farm" containing seventy-two and one-fourth acres, more or less about three miles from Greenville Court House on the Laurens Road and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the Laurens road and running thence N. 77 E. 16.69 to a stone 34.34. n.m.; thence N. 62 1/2 E. 5.02 to a stone 34.34. n.m. by a small Pine (down); thence S. 23 3/4 E. 33.57 to a stone 34.34. o.m.; thence S. 66 1/4 W. 22.35 across the road to a stone 34.34. o.m. at H. Pool's corner; thence N. 23 1/5 W. 3.14 to a stone 34.34. o.m. (formerly Vickers corner) thence N. 66 1/4 E. 3.62 to a stone 34.34. o.m. on Laurens Road; thence with said road N. 34 1/2 W. 14.01 to a stone; thence N. 24 1/4 W. 10.24 to a stone 34.34. o.m.; thence S. 42 1/4 W. 28 links to a stone 34.34. o.m.; thence N. 23 1/5 W. 9.10 to the beginning and fully represented by a plat made by W. W. Shellkild N.S. 25 November 1872 and known as lot #2 of the Real Estate of Lavinia Pool, deceased, the same being his interest in the Real Estate of the said John F.
